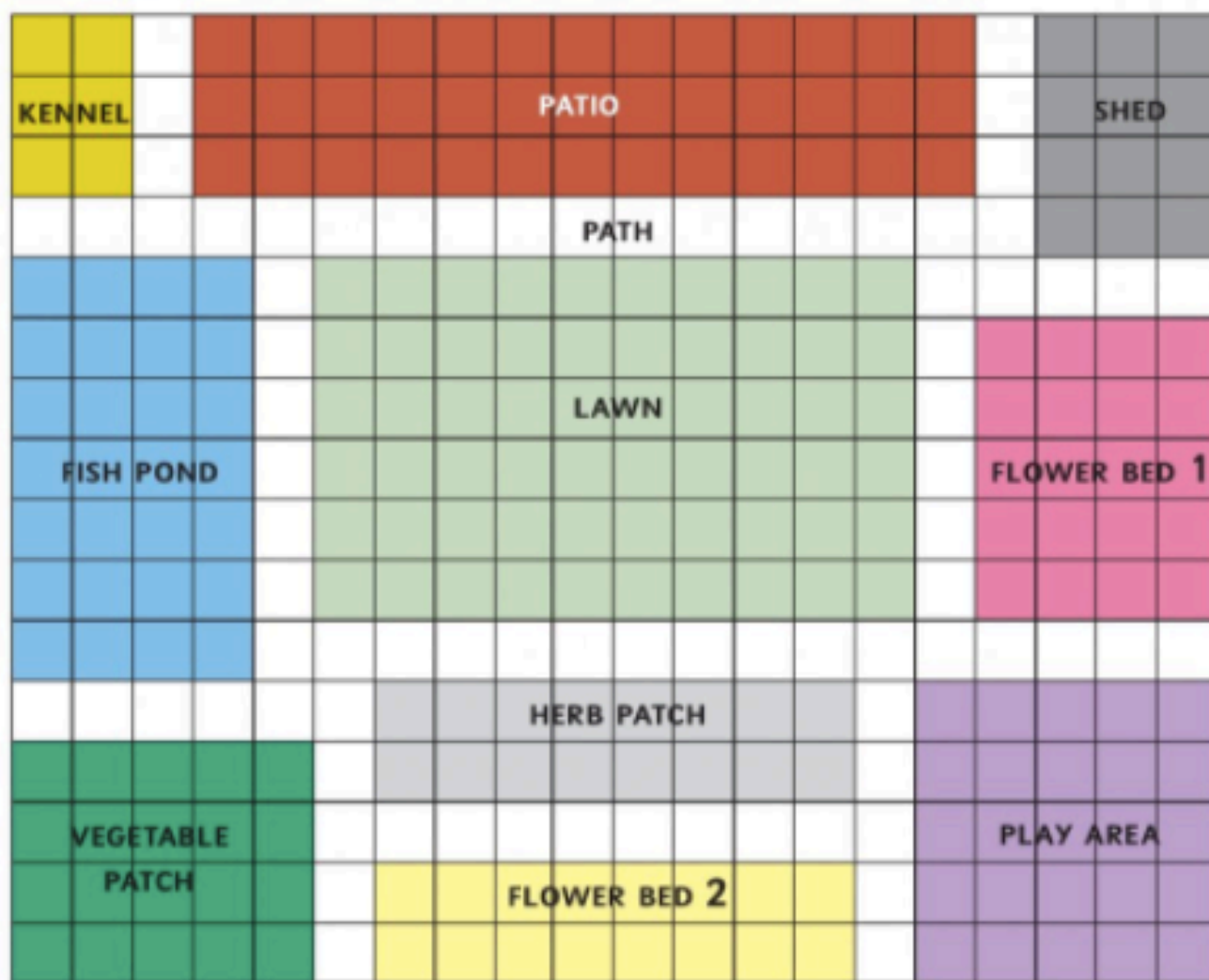


Area – The garden
