1. Jolly Phonics:

- Read "ie" words (posted to Seesaw/School website.)

- 3. Reading:

You can find the Story Sparks/ Oxford Reading Tree/SongBirds Phonics series readers in here which we use in school. Our class is probably level 2 up, but I would start at level 1 for practice and keep going on up the levels! It's great for confidence to fly through the starting levels. - "Reading Eggs" if you are on it and looking for more material.

- Comprehension : Make Links (e.g. What does this story remind you of in your life?/ Does it remind you of any other stories/films/songs/poems?; Predictions(What do you think will happen next?) during reading engaged in this week.

4. Read Jolly Phonics Tricky words Set 4 (1^{st} 4 words). (Posted to Seesaw and website.)

5. Genre Writing: (Recount.)

- Write a Recount about your weekend.

1. Tell your story orally first (Include: When/Where/Who/What happened)

2. Plan the writing. (Under the headingsWhen/Where/Who/What draw a picture/write a word. (Seelink to Recount Template on email/ School website.

3. Use your plan to write the recount.

Resist the temptation to spell for them. Approximate spelling is what you are aiming for. Half a page or more and a lovely colourful picture would be fab! Encourage them to clap/stretch out the sounds in words if needs be. I would love to see some of your work if possible[©] Maths (Number 7):
