# English:

# 1. Jolly Phonics:

- Recall and sing Jolly Phonics"ai" song with actions. (Song on Seesaw/School website)
- Read "ai" words (posted to Seesaw/School website.)

# 2. Spellwell:

- Spelling Test. (10 words from Spellwell this week) Encourage your child to sound out the words themselves (clap/stretch out the sounds or tap the sounds out in their head/shoulders/knees! (They will know what you are taking about ... I hope(!) as we do this in school all the time.) Post tests to Seesaw/email if you are able!

### 3. Reading:

- Read as much as they like from Reader if it is not already completed.
- Try <a href="www.oxfordowl.co.uk">www.oxfordowl.co.uk</a> for free graded readers. You can find the Story Sparks/ Oxford Reading Tree/SongBirds Phonics series readers in here which we use in school. Our class is probably level 2 up, but I would start at level 1 for practice and keep going on up the levels! It's great for confidence to fly through the starting levels.
- "Reading Eggs" if you are on it.
- Comprehension: Make Links (e.g. What does this story remind you of in your life? / Does it remind you of any other stories/films/songs/poems?; Predictions(What do you think will happen next?) during reading engaged in this week.
- 4. Read Jolly Phonics Tricky words Set 3. (Posted already to Seesaw and website.)
- 5. Genre Writing: (Recount)
- Write a Recount entitled: The Frosty Day.
- 1. Tell your story orally first (Include: When/Where/Who/What happened)
- 2. Plan the writing. (Under the headings When/Where/Who/What draw a picture/write a word. (See link to Recount Template on email/ School website.
- 3. Use your plan to write the recount.

You can give some help. Approximate spelling is what you are aiming for. Half a page or more and a lovely colourful picture would be fab! Encourage them to clap/stretch out the sounds in words if needs be. I would love to see some of your work if possible ©

\*On Friday's we try to incorporate English games e.g. Try a boardgame if you have one!

### Maths (3D shapes):

- Recall and sing along to 3D Shape song( Seesaw/School website.)
- Recall the characteristics of cube/cuboid/cylinder/sphere.
- Recall the differences between 3d shapes.
- Recall which 3D shapes roll/do not roll.
- Brainstorm what shapes are useful for what purposes.

\*On Fridays we try to do Fun Maths: 3D
Rocket/Robot/Anything else you would like to make! Search for cube/cylinder/cuboid/sphere shapes in the recycling bin/elsewhere and get creative! (Only if you have time Mums/Dads... I know you are all busy. Post if you can. :)

- Recall yesterday's sentences (abairtí):

- 1. Tá an lá fuar inniu. (The day is cold.)
- 2. Tá an lá té inniu. (The day is hot.)
- 3. Tá an lá fluich inniu. (The day is wet.)
- 4. Tá an lá tirim inniu. (The day is dry.)
- 5. Tá an la gaofar inniu. (The day is windy.)
- 6. Tá an lá scamalach inniu. (The day is cloudy.)
- Sing and clap along to: "Tá an Lá Fuar Inniu." (Seesaw/School Website)
- Complete attached worksheet: An Aimsir. (Tarraing (draw) agus dathaigh (colour)various weather elements above.). I would love to see the completed work. :)

# Circle Time (SPHE): (Friendship and Bullying.)

- What can you do if you notice someone else being bullied? (1. Stand up to the bully (most difficult(!) 2. Distract the bully. 3. Interrupt the bullying. 4. Tell an adult who can help.
